

NOTICE OF RACE  
SAISA Women's Fall Championship  
Oct. 27-28, 2023

Location: Haney Landing Sailing Center – University of South Florida St. Petersburg, FL

Boats: 18 FJ's

Entrants: Eckerd, NC State, Rollins, Georgia Tech, Georgia, Embry-Riddle, USF, Florida State, Florida, Jacksonville, Miami, Charleston, Auburn (13 schools)

Racing: Racing will be either in Bayboro Harbor (in close proximity to the College of Marine Science parking lot) or on Tampa Bay (south of the Bayboro Channel, east of Lassing Park). Three races per division shall constitute a regatta. A maximum of 13 races per division will be sailed.

Schedule:

- Friday
  - Report time: 12:00pm
  - Competitors meeting 12:15pm
  - Racing as soon as practicable
- Saturday
  - Report time: 9:00am
  - Racing as soon as practicable
  - No race will be started after 12:30pm

Format: Teams will rotate boats after **three races** using the rotations posted on Techscore.

Divisions: Division A and B will sail separately.

IMPORTANT VENUE INFORMATION: When leaving or returning to the dock, you MUST stay as close as possible to the large research ship(s) on the EAST side of the passageway. To the west is a charter boat named "Ships Ahoy". You must maintain a minimum 5 boat length distance from "Ships Ahoy". Violations will be dealt with harshly.

Qualification: All SAISA programs in good standing are welcome. All competitors must be registered with the ICSA individual Directory.

Course: Courses will be Windward/Leewards with a windward offset and a leeward gate.

Coaching: Coaches will be onshore if the racing area is Bayboro Harbor, and on a designated coach boat if the racing area is Tampa Bay.

Water: Please bring refillable containers for water. A bottle refill station is available at the venue and water coolers are available on the water.

Directions: Google Map search to “Haney Landing Sailing Center” or “USF SP Sailing Center” for the drop-off location.

Parking: Free parking is available at the east end of 8<sup>th</sup> Ave SE and on 3<sup>rd</sup> St South, obeying parking signs. Nearby metered street parking is available for \$1 per hour but must be renewed every 3 hours.
